

Little wonder that state senators targeted for recall campaigns are attracting giant wads of cash. Under normal campaign finance rules, individuals are limited to thousand dollar donations. Not for recall campaigns. Not until the recall is made official. A new report from the Wisconsin Democracy Campaign suggests that may be why Republican senator Roberta Darling has managed to amass \$420 thousand dollars in donations since the beginning of the year. She's the top contribution recipient in the state among the recall targets. La Crosse republican Dan Kapanke is number two. His campaign contributions have totaled over \$180 thousand since the beginning of the year. Meanwhile, democrat Jennifer Shilling, Kapanke's opponent in the recall race, hasn't filed a campaign finance report since January.
