

The Holmen School District employee accused of manufacturing drugs at his home pleads 'not guilty'...

Dustin Wood of Onalaska entered his plea earlier this week, meaning the case will go to trial. He's charged with five drug-related counts, including growing marijuana and warehousing drugs. Police searched Wood's home this month and found packages of pot, along with marijuana being grown outside.
