

La Crosse Fluoride Levels Likely to Decrease

A cavity-fighting agent in your drinking water appears likely to get less concentrated soon. The feds recommended a year ago to drop the level of fluoride put in municipal supplies to point-7 parts per million. The state of Wisconsin has finally agreed. La Crosse water utility manager Mark Johnson says he's not surprised by the change
