

Craig Nestor says he wants to lead the city of La Crosse as mayor. But he also wants to sue the city. Nestor, one of 11 candidates for mayor, has informed WIZM that he plans to file a lawsuit against the city in circuit court on the basis of rampant mismanagement of development deals. Nestor claims a lack of transparency, a failure to follow through on legal contractual obligations, and abuse by the city's board of public works. Nestor also charges city planner Larry Kirch with running a sort of secret empire through La Crosse's Redevelopment Authority. Nestor will address those issues when he joins Mitch Reynolds after 5 today on WIZM.
