



A package of jobs bills released Tuesday by Governor Scott

Walker would cost \$8.5 million dollars in state funds, with an extra \$13 million in federal funds. The most expensive bill comes from Democrats. La Crosse Senator Jennifer Shilling proposed \$4 million dollars for vocational rehab services to help those with disabilities. She explains the cost involved.
