He admitted that fewer than 27 thousand Americans selected an insurance plan through the federal healthcare.gov site, which is handling enrollment for 36 states. Meanwhile, under 900 have signed up in Wisconsin. Gunderson Health System's Greg Skempf says concerns are rising here.
