



Last week, 96% of UW-L students voted in favor of a new policy that will give underage students a chance to call 911 if another student is drunk and in an emergency. The policy protects the student from getting into trouble. A big reason Devin Remiker, who crafted the policy, says some students end up either in the hospital or dead from drinking too much.
