Jesse Herrmann pleads 'not guilty' to homicide and other charges resulting from a collision that killed an Onalaska woman...

The La Crosse County D-A has filed eight charges against Herrmann, for the crash a week ago in which his pickup rear-ended a car carrying five women on Highway 35. Herrmann tells Judge Ramona Gonzalez that he'll waive his right to an evidence hearing.

That means a trial date will be set. The prison terms for all eight charges could be increased by six years, because of Herrmann's status as a repeat offender.
