

Poll Finds Less Than Half in Wisconsin Want Walker Recall

Looking to recall Wisconsin governor Scott Walker? You're in the minority in the state. That's the findings of a new poll conducted for a free market group in New York. According to the poll for the Manhattan Institute for Policy Research, 44% of Wisconsinites are in favor of recalling governor Walker but a solid 50% say no to that process. Meanwhile, the same poll finds that Wisconsinites are almost perfectly evenly split on the job Walker's doing.
