A car with red and blue flashing lights isn't always a police car. Like the SUV that belongs to 47 year-old Kevin Shirel, a La Crosse guy who's been arrested for impersonating a police officer. Cops say they've been on the trail of Shirel since January when he apparently stopped some kids while driving his Dodge and asked for their ID's. They say he's been flashing a gun and a Fugitive Recovery Agent badge, saying he's contracting for La Crosse county. In a letter to the FBI Shirel apologizes for his acts, says he remembers very little about what he's accused of doing.
