

34 states and the District of Columbia have accepted \$850 million in federal funds to build their own health exchanges, but Wisconsin hasn't accepted a dime. The Governor plans to wait through November to see how the Presidential election turns out. Democrat, Jon Erpenbach, says that's not good enough.
