

Western Technical College will present voters with a \$79.8 million facilities referendum on the November 6th election ballot. Prior to that, the college will be hosting information sessions around the district. The first session will be held Wednesday, August 29th at the Lunda Center on Western's La Crosse campus. And President, Lee Rasch, says he expects finances to be a hot topic.

The referendum will be presented to voters in the Western Technical College district, which covers all or part of 11 counties, including Buffalo, Clark, Crawford, Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Monroe, Richland, Sauk, Trempealeau, and Vernon.
