

Marshfield Fire Exceeds \$1 Million In Damage

MARSHFIELD, Wis. (AP) Damage from a weekend fire at a food ingredient plant in central Wisconsin is estimated at \$1 million.

Marshfield fire officials say the blaze at Quality Ingredients Corp., was contained to a drying unit inside one of the company's buildings. Deputy Chief Craig DeGrand says the fire destroyed about \$1 million worth of processed food product.

Firefighters were on the scene Sunday morning for about six hours.
