



Half of Tomah's alcohol licensees failed compliance checks during

the three most recent quarterly rounds of random compliance checks. The latest in May. Now the city council has created an ad hoc alcohol licensing review committee. Police Chief Mark Nicholson says it's something that's been thought of for awhile now.
