

First, his wife went down....now....a Tomah man will follow her to prison after his sentencing.

58 year old Dennis Deeny was a part owner of Affordable Homes and kept over \$200 grand of monies collected after the sale of 4 homes. Now he will spend the next 21 months in prison for bank fraud.

His 43 year old wife, Yvonne, has already been sentenced to 3 years behind bars after being charged with 47 counts of forgery and fraudulent writings by a corporate officer.

Deeny's crime had serious consequences on his business partner, Gary Koznick, who had to repay the bank despite not taking a salary from Affordable Homes for a few years.
